

Folder for CD pockets



Material:

Glue or tape and decorations

If you have a cameo:

One cardstock for the frame

One patterned paper

If you have a Portrait or an older model:

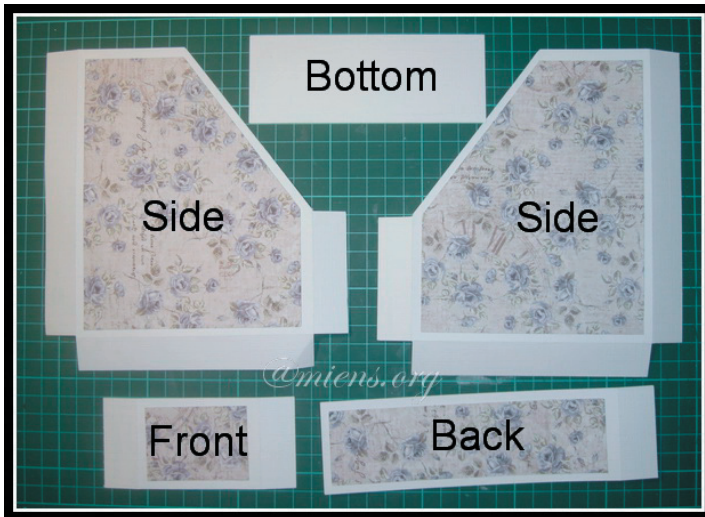
Two cardstock for the frame

One patterned paper

Start of course to cut out all the parts. This folder comes in two files, one containing the parts to the frame ([mien_magazine_file](#)) and the other parts of the panels ([mien_magazine_file_panels](#)). The file is made for the Cameo, do you have a different model, change the Mat to the one you usually use. A narrower mat also means that you can not cut out all the parts of the body at once, you have to move around the parts and cut in two rounds.



Align the panels with the right pieces from the body.
Bend the tabs at the perforation so it's easier to get the panels in the middle.



Here you can see witch part is what , so that you know what parts I mean when we are going to assemble this.



Start with one of the sides and the back. Glue the tab on the side and then attach the back side, edge to edge with the crease.

Ensure that the bottom is in the same direction in both parts and the folds are aligned with each other.



Glue the other side the same way and let dry.

Time for the little bit that becomes the front.



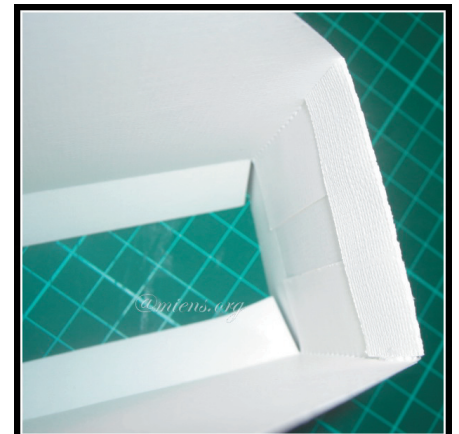
Glue it in the same way you did with the back. Glue on the tab and attach the front on the tab. Be sure that the bottom and the folds forming line.

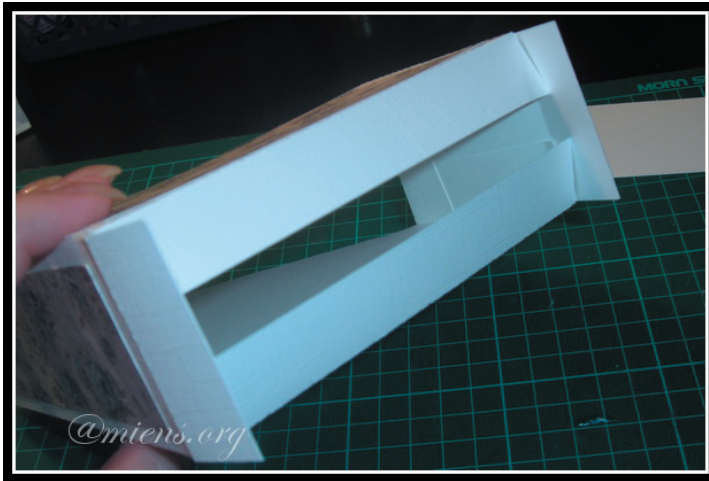
Glue the second tab and let dry.



To get a good-looking, and sustainable, edge, fold down the upper flap on the front and attach it to the inside of the folder with glue.

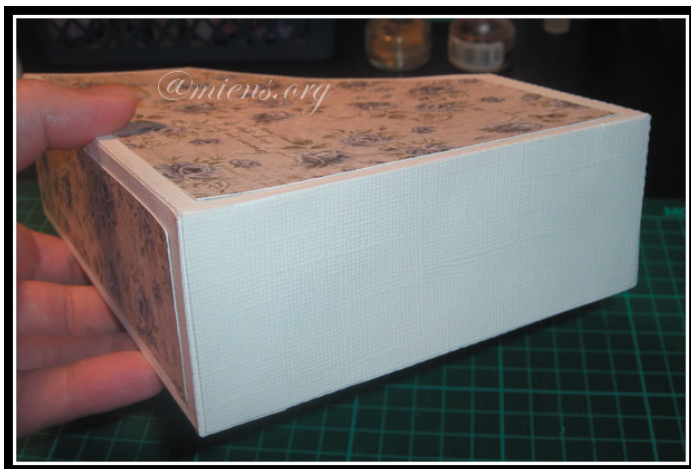
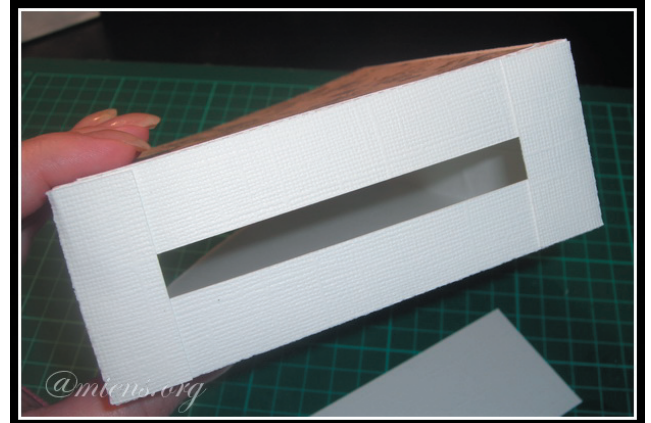
Have you set the front too far down it becomes cumbersome to bring down this edge, so be sure to get it right from the start.





Only the bottom left then. Fold the long sides first and then glue the short sides.

If it is difficult to get the sides to stay folded down, it might help to set something heavy in the folder while the glue dries.



Then glue the bottom in place over the tabs. Be sure to glue the edges so as the bottom not to come off.

Done! Just to decorate as you wish.
